

Hospitality Rider

Dressing Room

Please provide a clean, private, secure dressing room with fresh towels, washing facilities (shower if possible), adequate lighting and a full-length mirror. The dressing room should be lockable and a key given to the bands tour manager or representative on arrival at the venue

Dressing Room Hospitality Rider

24 x cans or bottles of beer (Budweiser, Fosters, Carling, Red Stripe)

10 x assorted cans of soft drinks (Pepsi, Coke, Fanta, 7Up etc.)

10 x bottles of still mineral water

1 x bottle of red wine

1 x 750ml bottle of either Jack Daniels or Grey Goose Vodka

Bucket of ice

Selection of snacks (biscuits, crisps, nuts, fresh fruit etc)

Tea, coffee, milk, sugar plus a kettle and cups

In addition to the above please provide 8 x bottles of still mineral water on stage prior to the bands set commencing

Food

Upon arrival/load-in to the venue, please ensure that the entire above hospitality rider is in the dressing room

For dinner, please provide a hot, healthy meal (no takeaways) for four persons in a dining area near the dressing room (or in dressing room if it is large enough). Our goal is to have a convenient meal for the artist so that they do not have to leave the venue between sound check and performance. Usually the band would prefer to eat dinner 2 hours in advance of the performance time; please confirm with the tour manager / artist representative. If the above is not possible, then the promoter may choose an alternative option: a food buyout for four people at £12 / €14 / \$16 per person to be paid to the tour manager / artist representative in cash three hours before scheduled performance time. If possible, please provide menus and phone number for a local quality restaurant that will deliver to the venue

Accommodation

When accommodation is part of the agreement with the promoter, we ask that you provide 4 rooms (4 x singles) at a quality hotel or an apartment type property would also be acceptable provided it has 4 bedrooms - clean, comfortable rooms are greatly appreciated
